

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To prevent mildew in laundered or treated fabric, use 1½ to 2½ fluid ounces of Kathon LM for every 100 gallons of final rinse. Alternatively, use ¼ to 1½ fluid ounces of Kathon LM in the final rinse for every 100 pounds of fabric treated. Fabric may be retreated as necessary to effect continued mildew protection. Fabric should be retreated after every laundering.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water.
