STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TREATMENT

Kathon WT 1.5% is recommended for the protection of wood and wood products such as landscape timbers, fences, posts, pilings, cribs, decks, and similar exterior structures from mild and mold. Treat southern yellow pine, hemlock, ponderosa pine and other softwoods with 148 to 1000 ppm Kathon WT 1.5% (11.26 to 8.4 pounds or 19 to 126 fluid ounces (1 gallon) of Kathon WT 1.5% per 1000 gallons) as an aqueous dip or pressure treatment for mild and mold control. Thoroughly wet and allow to dry. A single application will afford protection for 12 weeks. Kathon WT 1.5% weighs 8.4 pounds per gallon.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. If plastic, do not reuse empty container.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide or waste that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Triple rinse (or equivalent) all containers and, for metal containers, offer for recycling or reconditioning (for plastic containers dispose in an incinerator), or dispose in landfill approved for pesticide containers or bury in a safe place.
