

METALWORKING FLUIDS

Kathon 893 MW fungicide is used for the control of fungi in the use of soluble, synthetic metalworking fluids.

METHOD OF ADDITION: should be directly dispersed into the working concentrate or fluid using a metered pump or use device and uniformly throughout the fluid.

FLUID CONCENTRATION

Kathon 893 MW fungicide is used for the control of fungi in the use of soluble, synthetic metalworking fluids. The final use dilution is 55-167 ppm of product (active ingredient).

USE-DILUTION FLUID

INITIAL DOSE: For a new system, add 0.47-1.44 lbs. (7.21-25.75 oz.) of Kathon 893 MW fungicide per 1000 gal. This will provide 25-75 ppm (active ingredient). Repeat until control is achieved.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE: For a fouled system, add 0.09-0.27 lbs. (1.44-4.24 oz.) of Kathon 893 MW fungicide per 1000 gal. of emulsion every 4 weeks. A 5-30 ppm active ingredient range and/or increased frequency may be required depending on the nature and severity of contamination. Control required, filtration system design, etc.

Grossly contaminated systems should be cleaned before treatment is begun.

HYDRAULIC FLUIDS

Kathon 893 MW fungicide is used for the control of fungi in the use of soluble oils, high water content emulsion hydraulic fluids.

METHOD OF ADDITION: should be directly dispersed into the hydraulic concentrate or fluid using a metering pump or use device and uniformly throughout the fluid.
