- 2. Make the following label changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
  - a. Add the phrase, "EPA Reg. No. 707-230".
  - b. Modify the Environmental Hazard section to incorporate the following statements:

#### Environmental Hazards

This product is highly toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

The fiscal year begins October 1, and ends September 30. The product information will be submitted to the Agency no later than November 15, following the end of the preceding fiscal year.
