The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Octhilinone (OIT) RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FABRIC MILDEWCIDE

To prevent mildew in laundered or treated fabric, use 1 1/4 - 2 1/2 fluid ounces of this product for every 100 gallons (5-10 ppm active ingredient) of final rinse. Alternatively, use 3/4- 1 1/2 fluid ounces of this product in the final rinse for every 100 pounds (3-6 ppm active ingredient) of fabric treated. Fabric may be retreated as necessary to effect continued mildew protection. Fabric should be retreated after every laundering.

LEATHER PRESERVATIVE

This product is recommended for the prevention of mold, bacteria, and fungi in the storage and transport of wet leather stock such as pickled, chrome-tanned, and vegetable-tanned leather.

Use this product at the levels specified in the following table to prevent microbial growth on processed hides. The level used will depend on storage conditions and the length of protection required. Pre-dilute this product 5-20 times with water and add the diluted product to the chrome liquor at the start of the tanning process.
