STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area above freezing.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
