
The labeling referred to above is in compliance with the Diuron RED provided you make the following changes:

1. Change the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals statement to "Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin burns. Harmful if inhaled. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals."
2. To the label add the following PPE "Handlers must wear: Coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, Socks and chemical-resistant footwear, Chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, A chemical-resistant apron when mixing, loading, and cleaning equipment, Chemical-resistant headgear for overhead exposure, and A NIOSH-approved respirator with a dust/mist filter with MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C or any N, R, P or HE filter."
3. To the label add "Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables exist, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."
4. To the label add the following "User Safety Recommendations, User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, tobacco, or using the toilet, User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing., and Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."
5. To the label add under the heading "General Precautions and Restrictions" "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application."

concrete. Use 0.25 - 2.0 pounds of Roclain 63 per 100 pounds of formulation.
