To control algae and bacterial stimes, use SAVIN WATER TREATMENT MICROBIOCIDE as directed For best results, slug feed. The frequency of addition of microbiocide needed depends on many factors. To optimize your use of SAVIN WATER TREATMENT MICROBIOCIDE follow this procedure

#### Recirculating cooling Towers

Initially use 6 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water to be treated (20 ppm active quaternary).

Should the above dosage not give satisfactory results, use 9 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water

Repeat the initial dose every seven days or increase the frequency if needed.

 When the above treatment level is successful, use 2 to 3 fluid ounces per 1000 gallons of water to maximize efficiency. Repeat weekly as needed.

Should stime develop again, go back to initial dosage.

Cooling tower waters that are inherently low in algae growth and bacteria count may be adequately controlled by the lower range of these dosages; slug fed every seven days.
