1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. Preceding the paragraph which begins "CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed..." add the general heading PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS followed by the subheading HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS.
  - b. Change "Fish and Wildlife CAUTION" to ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS and change the statement "Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds" to "Do not apply directly to water."
  - c. Based on your product's reported flash point (135° F), add the subheading PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL Hazards followed by:
