Pyrethrins	.15%

N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide	.50%
Petroleum Distillate	99.05%
*Consists of .24% (butylcarbityl) (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and 0.06% other related compounds.	

- DIRECTIONS -

For barn fogging to control house flies, stable flies, horn flies, mosquitoes, and gnats, use approximately 1 ounce of PYROFOG for each 1000 cu. ft. of space. The cattle may either be in the barn or in the pasture at the time of application. Keep doors and windows closed for at least ten minutes and after application, sweep up and destroy all fallen insects. Follow directions of equipment manufacturer for proper positioning of the fogging machine.

CAUTION Keep out of reach of Children.

CAUTION Do not use near heat or open flame. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of milk and milk-handling equipment. Do not spray directly on animals with PYROFOG. Do not apply PYROFOG in poultry houses. Do not reuse empty container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place.
