**PEARSON'S 10% HEPTACHLOR GRANULAR**

IMPORTED FIRE ANT MOUND TREATMENT ON UNCULTIVATED LAND, such as lawns, golf courses, park areas, etc. Tear down mound with rake or hoe. Apply 1-2 cupsful of Pearson's 10% Heptachlor Granular to mound. Do not use more than 12½ lbs. per acre.

LAWN INSECTS. For lawn insects such as Japanese beetle larvae, white grubs, cutworms, white fringed beetle larvae, European chafer larvae, and Asiatic garden beetle larvae, apply 3 to 1½ lbs. per 1,000 square feet of Pearson's 10% Heptachlor Granular. Persons or pets should be excluded from the treated area until the Heptachlor has been worked, or washed into the soil. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.

WIREWORMS ON CORN, ROOTWORMS ON CORN. Apply 3 lb per 1,000 square feet, or 30 lbs. per acre of Pearson's 10% Heptachlor Granular prior to planting and mix into top 3 or 4 inches of soil.

ROW APPLICATION. Apply 3 to 1 lb per 100 ft. of row of Pearson's 10% Heptachlor Granular at planting.
