

PEARSON'S GRAIN SPRAY

A CONTACT SPRAY FOR THE CONTROL OF COMMON INSECTS FOUND IN GRAIN ELEVATORS, GRAIN STORAGE AREAS, PEANUT SHELLING PLANTS AND PLACES WHERE SHELLED PEANUTS ARE STORED. PEARSON'S GRAIN SPRAY WILL KILL THE EXPOSED STAGES OF THE FOLLOWING INSECTS:

DIRECTIONS: Completely close space to be treated and, using a coarse spray, cover area thoroughly, including ceilings. All storage areas and bins should be cleaned and thoroughly sprayed. Repeat applications as necessary. A sanitation program for all grain storage areas should be followed to keep insect breeding at a minimum.
