

**Outdoor Spray for Yard, Patio, Picnic Areas, Camping Areas

Spray from center  
when air is calm

Spray with wind,  
if breeze is blowing



**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.** Point spray nozzle away from face and toward area to be treated. Press button and allow fog to fill the air where flying insect pests linger. For best results, spray when there is no breeze or in the direction of a slight breeze, allowing insecticide fog to drift into infested areas. Spray while moving away from treated areas. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying treated area. Repeat as necessary.

**FLYING INSECTS:** Flies, mosquitoes, gnats and flying moths.—Spray with the breeze. Allow fog to drift over area to be protected. When treating grass or bushes, stand at least 4 to 6 feet away and drift spray onto areas to be protected. Spray breeding areas such as garbage cans. Repeat if necessary.

**WASPS:** Spray nests with a generous blast (at least 4-6 seconds) from a distance of about 2 feet—soaking the nest thoroughly with the spray. Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Apply at dusk or other times when wasps are quiet.

**CRAWLING INSECTS:** Ants, crickets, cockroaches—Spray infested surfaces of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants and cockroaches. Spray ant hills and trails thoroughly for best control.

**CAUTION:** Keep Out of Reach of Children.

Cover exposed food. Do not smoke while spraying. Avoid skin contact with spray. Avoid inhalation. Do not spray toward face. Do not apply to food crops or household pets.

Not for indoor use. Keep 4-6 feet away from ornamental plants while spraying.

Spray from this product is toxic to fish. Do not allow spray to drift to fish ponds or any body of water.

Dispose of empty container through regular municipal garbage or trash pick-up. Do not discard empty container where it, or residues from it, can contaminate our environment.

**WARNING:** Flammable! Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting.
