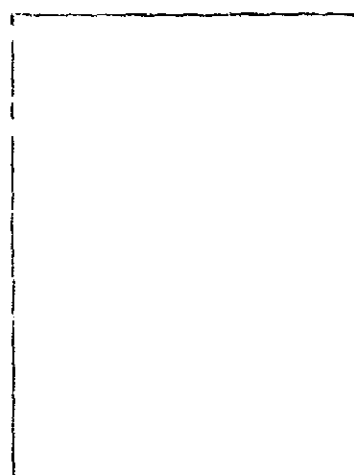

GULFSRAY QUICK ACTION INSECTICIDE when sprayed as a fine mist knocks out of the air and quickly kills flies, mosquitoes, gnats, moths, and wasps hit by the spray. It also quickly kills roaches, ants, silverfish, bedbugs, and fleas, that are wet with the spray.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Contains Petroleum Naphtha. If swallowed call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Persons hypersensitive to ingredients may suffer irritation and should not use this spray. Do not direct mist on humans, pets, plants, foodstuffs, or food utensils. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

Cover bird cages and fish bowls when spraying. Asphalt tile, linoleum, and plastic materials may discolor and soften when wet with petroleum base insecticides. Test such materials by spraying or wetting a small area. Never use this spray in a dirty or rusty sprayer, or in a sprayer containing any other material.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, FLYING MOTHS, WASPS: Spray insects, or fog room with mist. Close doors and windows for ten minutes during treatment. Wet hornets and wasps.

CLOTHES MOTHS: Kill moths, their eggs and larvae by hitting them with spray. Moth-infested woolen articles should be brushed well, then sprayed thoroughly, especially in seams and folds. Spray woollens in use, and fog clothes closets every two weeks. Allow sprayed articles to dry completely before using.

BEDBUGS: Spray slats, springs, mattress, and all joints of bed. Air mattress until dry. Spray cracks in room and furniture. Repeat when necessary.

ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH: Spray insects, cracks, and places where they hide. When the insects run out, spray them with coarse spray.

ANTS, FLEAS: Spray ants and ant trails. Repeat when necessary. To kill fleas, spray heavily floors, rugs, and lower walls of rooms and basements, and animal sleeping quarters. Repeat until fleas disappear.

SPIDERS, CENTIPEDES, SCORPIONS: Wet them with spray.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

Do not reuse empty container. Discard in a safe place.
