DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hold valve 8 to 10 inches from skin or clothing. Point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Apply liberally to all exposed skin areas. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. Repeat whenever insects become annoying. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings of clothing.

Instruct older children to the proper use of this product. Do not spray toward eyes or mouth.

Avoid contact with plastics such as eyeglass frames and such fabrics as acetate rayon, Dipel, and spandex.
