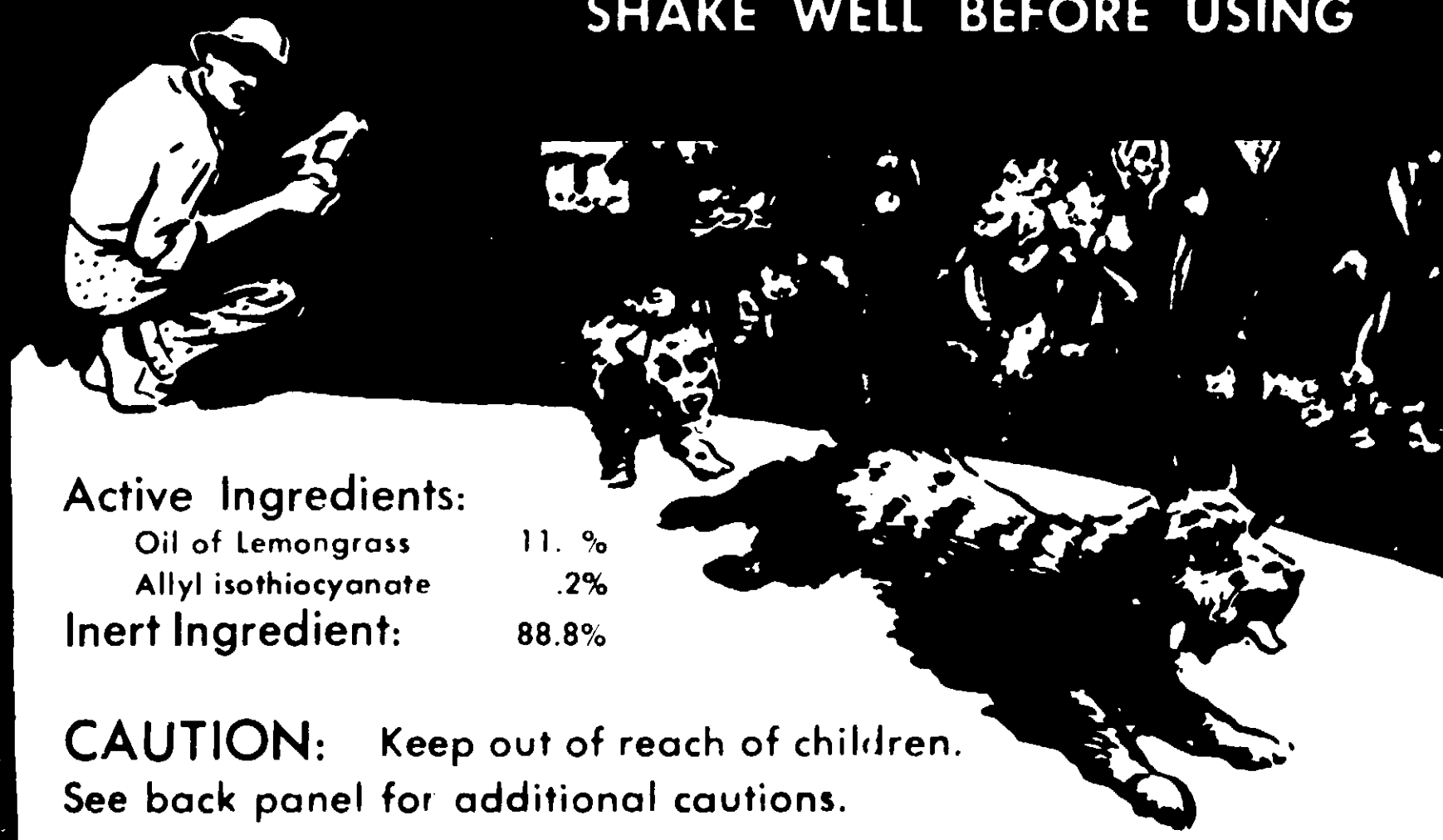

Chaperone can be used on lawns, shrubs, doorsteps, garbage cans, etc., but do not spray directly on the growth of annuals or shrubbery.
