DIRECTIONS

Use a VERY LIGHT SPRAY with rapid sweeping motion and never closer than twenty inches. Peapply regularly at least once a week for a month then gradually lessen the reapplication.

To make sure this material is compatible with your furniture covering, spray Indoor CHAPERONE on a small "Test" area before spraying it generally on furniture, draperies, rugs, etc. Keep can upright.

While odor may seem strong at first, it quickly dissipates so that it is not perceptible to humans. Pets can still smell it and, since CHAPERONE is a training product, soon associate their discomfort with that particular area, (chair, bed, etc.) and stay away from it. Continue to employ verbal commands until CHAPERONE becomes associated with the forbidden act.

CAUTION: Do not spray toward eyes. Do not store above 120° F. Do not puncture can or throw into fire or incinerator.
