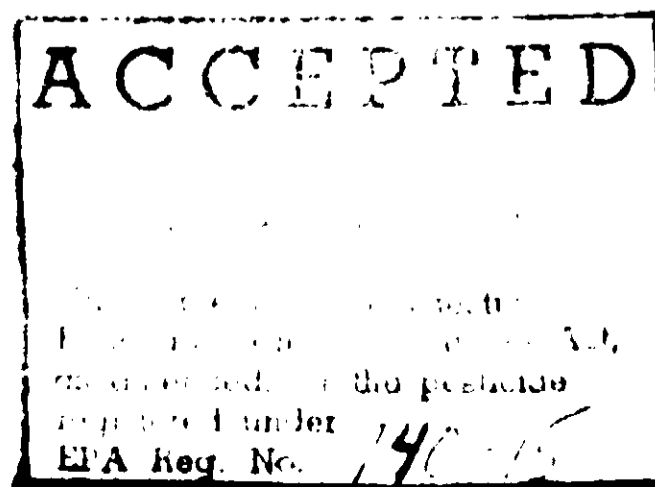

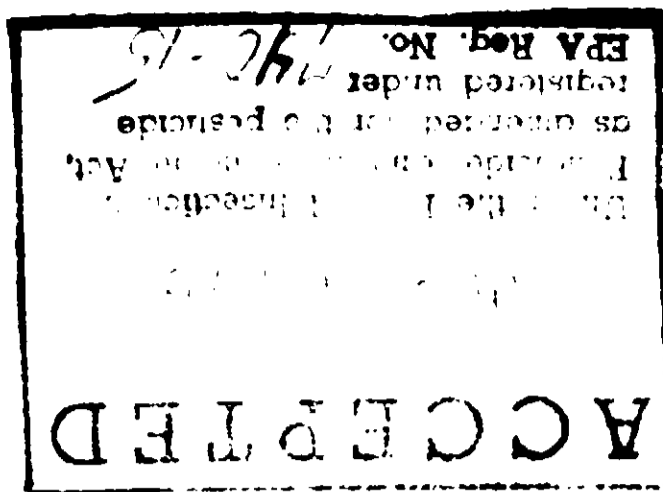

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Feed PEET'S Vita Ferm FC (contains RABON and larvicide) at the rate of $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce per 100 pounds body weight daily by mixing it into the ground grain or complete beef or dairy ration. This supplies an average daily intake of 70 milligrams of RABON per 100 pounds of body weight.

Start feeding PEET'S Vita Ferm FC early in the spring before flies begin to appear, and continue feeding throughout the summer and into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity.

PEET'S Vita Ferm FC may be fed up to slaughter, and also to lactating dairy cows producing marketable milk.

PEET'S Vita Ferm FC prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle but is not effective against existing adult flies. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, it may be necessary to use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

Supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around cattle lots and buildings to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed not only in cattle manure but in other decaying vegetable matter on large farm premises.

In order to achieve optimum fly control, PEET'S Vita Ferm FC should be used in conjunction with other good management and sanitation practices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water or food by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Dispose of the container in an incinerator or landfill approved for pesticide containers, or bury in a safe place.
