DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR DISINFECTION AGAINST SALMONELLA CHOLERAESUIS:

May be used for disinfecting livestock premises (not to include poultry or dairy buildings) animal quarters, barns, kennels, pens, and sties. Do not use in milking stalls, milking parlors, or milk houses. Remove all animals and feeds from premises, cars, trucks, and crates. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities and fixtures occupied or traversed by animals and then use a solution of one cup MFA Disinfectant to 10 quarts of water. Saturate all surfaces with the above disinfecting solution. Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers. Ventilate buildings, cars, and other closed spaces. Do not house livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse. Apply disinfectant only at the recommended rates.

WATER CLOSETS, SINKS AND URINALS:

Wash the floor, walls, and fixtures with a solution of MFA Disinfectant in water. Rinse with clean water. Flush the toilet. Repeat the procedure for all fixtures.

GARBAGE:

Toss garbage daily in a covered container. Wash the container with a solution of MFA Disinfectant in water. Rinse with clean water. Repeat the procedure for all fixtures.

This product conforms with the specifications of the United States Department of Agriculture for a permitted Cresylic Disinfectant used in regulatory work coming within the purview of the regulations governing the interstate movement of livestock.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

New M.F.A. 50% Cresylic Disinfectant mixes readily with soft water. When unusually hard water is used, add enough washing soda to soften it.

FOR GENERAL SANITATION: Clean up barns and yards thoroughly and spray with a solution of 1/6 pint of Disinfectant in one gallon of water. If a disease has been present the solution should be 1/4 pint Disinfectant in one gallon of water.

NOTE: This product should not be used in or around milk parlors or dairy barns, because it will impart odor to milk. Consult your veterinarian on this product concerning its use in dairy barns.

FOR DISINFECTING DOG KENNELS: If disease has been present, clean up everything and spray kennels and runs with a solution of 1/4 pint Disinfectant in one gallon of water. Wash shipping crates with the same solution. For routine disinfection and flea prevention use 1/6 pint Disinfectant to one gallon of water. Repeat as often as necessary.

WARNING: Keep out of reach of children. May be fatal if absorbed through the skin. May produce severe burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

FIRST AID TREATMENT—EXTERNAL: Flush with water. Bathe skin with olive oil, salad oil or kerosene oil. Consult a physician.

ANTIDOTE INTERNAL:

Give milk, white of egg, flour and water paste or corn starch and water paste. Follow with an emetic such as a tablespoon of mustard in a glass of water. Call a physician.

DESTROY USED CONTAINERS—Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

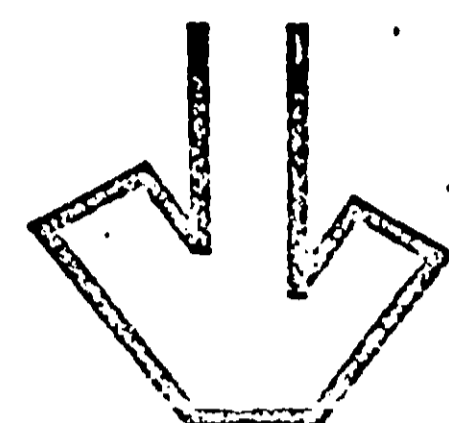

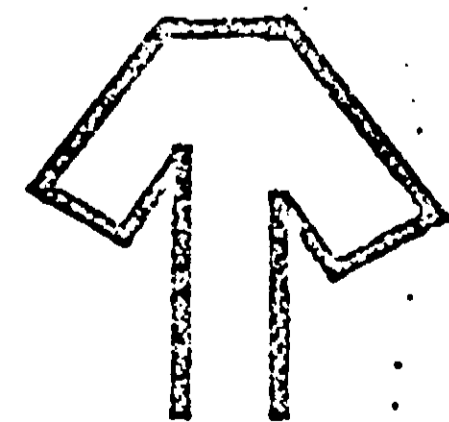
