

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

As an aid to general sanitation and lice control on beef cattle, swine, and horses. Apply Dry Dip liberally in the bedding, and on the animals. For lice control on horses repeat treatment every 15 to 20 days, and on beef cattle every 10 to 15 days. Repeat treatment of swine and bedding as necessary. Do not apply on beef cattle and swine within 28 days of slaughter. Do not apply to animals under 6 weeks of age. Do not use on dairy cattle.

CAUTION:

Keep out of reach of children. Avoid breathing of dust. If swallowed, induce vomiting and call a physician. Avoid prolonged skin contact. Do not get in eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.
