DIRECTIONS

**CRABGRASS:** Apply in the spring before crabgrass germinates—3 pints Chlordane per 1000 square feet mixed in sufficient water to enable uniform application. After application wash off grass with hose and keep children and pets off until ground has dried.

**NOTE:** Chlordane should be used in established lawns and turfs only, as it may injure seedling grasses. Allow 30 days to elapse between application and re-seeding.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing spray mist. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Keep out of reach of children.

### DIRECTIONS

Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes."

**Soil Insects:** (White Grubs, Japanese Beetle Grub, Sod Webworm, Wireworms and others) Dilute one cup Chlordane with 3 gallons water and apply to 1000 square feet of lawn. Immediately after treating, water lawn heavily.

**Lawn Insects:** (chiggers, ants)

For control of chiggers, mix 1/2 cup Chlordane with 1 gallon water and apply to 2000 square feet. Make first application when chiggers are noticed. Repeat in 1 to 2 months. Control of Ants: Mix 2 tablespoons Chlordane per gallon of water. Pour directly on and in ant hills.

**Termite Control:** If infestation is severe, call a professional pest control operator. To prevent termite infestation, dig a trench 30 inches deep and 6 inches wide all around the house. Mix Chlordane at 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water or 5 tablespoons per 1 gallon of water. Pour mixture in trench at a total rate of one gallon per linear foot. Pour about half of it in the bottom of the trench, and use the rest to treat the dirt as it is put back in the trench.
