

DIRECTIONS

Cattle Spray is a ready-to use spray solution for use in conventional hand mist or automatic spray equipment.

Cattle: Dairy and Beef

For control of houseflies, hornflies, stableflies, faceflies, and mosquitoes on dairy cattle: mist one ounce, (2 tablespoons), over each animal after milking in the morning, and one ounce, (2 tablespoons), over each animal after milking in the evening, with a good mist type sprayer. For control of these insects on beef cattle and non-lactating dairy animals apply according to above directions. Apply so as to wet the hair, but do not wet the skin. Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including legs, and underside. Do not apply in excess of 2 fluid ounces per day per animal. Do not apply to calves under 6 months of age. Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

NOTE: Cattle Spray should not be used in a high pressure sprayer:

Animal Buildings: Dairy barns, beef barns, horse stables, and loafing sheds.

Apply cattle spray as a mist spray, at the rate of 1 pint per 8,000 cubic feet, (40 X 20 X 10). Before applying, reduce air movement as much as possible by closing doors, windows and other openings. Remove all animals prior to treatment. Do not apply in milking area or milk room. Do not contaminate milk or milking utensils.

Warning:

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water, for eyes get medical attention. Keep away from open flame. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate feed, water, or foodstuffs. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal.

Destroy used Containers: Do not reuse for any purpose. Destroy in the container by rinsing thoroughly with water and dilute lime. Destroy containers by crushing and burning fragments in incinerator. All parts of rinsing in a way as not to constitute a hazard, or contribute to water pollution.
