Do not use on pets or humans. In case of spillage on skin, wash with soap and water. If swallowed, drink emetic of mustard and call a physician. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material has been thoroughly watered into the soil and the grass is dry. Do not apply to food crops after edible parts begin to form. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

WHITE-FRINGED BEETLE LARVAE (Limited to the 8 Southeastern states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee.) - **BROADCAST TREATMENT** - Cropland to be planted to beans, beets, blackberries, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, celery, grapes, cabbage, kohlrabi, loganberries, peanuts, peppers, potatoes, raspberries, rutabaga, strawberries, sweet potatoes and turnips can be treated prior to planting. Apply at the rate of 5 to 10 pints per acre (¼ to ½ cup in 5 gallons of water applied to 1000 square feet) in sufficient water for coverage. On land not planted, disc into the soil before planting. On existing plantings, water thoroughly after application.

JAPANESE BEETLE LARVAE, IMPORTED FIRE ANT (Limited to use under Federal/State Quarantine Programs) - Ornamentals, Turf, and Sod - Apply at the rate of 5 to 10 pints per acre (¼ to ½ cup in 5 gallons of water applied to 1000 square feet) in sufficient water for coverage. Disc into the soil before planting. On existing plantings, water thoroughly after application.

TERMITES - For trenching around foundation, pillars and other possible entry-ways, use 1 part Chlordane EC8 to 100 parts of water. The diluted material should be applied at the rate of 1 gallon per linear foot of a trench 1 foot wide and 2½ feet deep. Where it is necessary to dig only a shallow trench a few inches deep, one gallon will treat 2 linear feet. The trench should be dug down to the footing of the foundation (do not undermine the foundation) and supporting piers. Add one half of the material to the bottom of the trench and the remaining material to the soil as it is replaced in the trench. For treating the surface soil of exposed areas such as under porches, dilute at the rate of 1 part Chlordane EC-8 to 100 parts of water and apply at the rate of 2 gallons per square yard. Make termite examinations annually and retreat when necessary.

IMPORTED FIRE ANTS - BROADCAST TREATMENT - Apply 1 to 1½ pints per acre in sufficient water for coverage (1 tablespoon per 1000 square feet). Do not treat when soil is wet. Do not apply to pasture and rangeland. Do not contaminate feed and food crops.

STORAGE - Do not store near food or feedstuffs. Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep out of reach of children.

DISPOSAL - Rinse equipment and container and dispose of wastes and spillage by burying in noncropland areas away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed of by punching holes in them and burying with wastes.
