GENERAL DIRECTIONS

CONTROL OF STABLE FLIES, HORN FLIES, FACE FLIES ON DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE:

A. Using High Volume and High Pressure Application: Mix 1/2 pint CIODRIN E.C. in 3 gallons of water. Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal using 1-2 quarts of a 5.5% concentration and proportionately less for smaller animals. DO NOT repeat applications more often than once every 7 days.

B. Using Low Volume (Hand Mist) Application: Mix 4 tablepoons CIODRIN E.C. in 1 1/2 pints of water. Mist to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including legs, using 2 to 4 tablepoons of spray per animal. Apply daily with hand mist sprayer.

CONTROL OF FACE FLIES ONLY ON DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE:

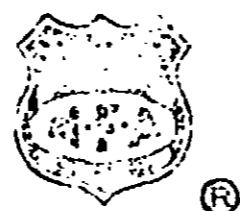
Mix 2 tablepoons CIODRIN E.C. in 1 1/2 pints of water using a calibrated sprayer, or hand mist sprayer, apply 1 tablepoon of spray to face and neck of animal 2 to 3 times per week.

CONTROL OF LICE AND WINTER TICKS ON DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS AND HOGS:

Mix 1 pint CIODRIN E.C. in 12 gallons of water. Spray animals thoroughly using up to 1 gallon of spray for large animals and proportionately less for smaller animals. Make a second application 14 days later. Repeat as necessary to maintain control. DO NOT apply more often than once every 7 days.

BACKRUBBER APPLICATIONS FOR USE BY DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE

For use in backrubbers or face-rubbers, for control of horn flies and eye flies, mix 1 pint of CIODRIN E.C. in 5 1/2 gallons of either NO. 1 or NO. 2 Diesel Fuel. Keep backrubber or face-rubber charged at all times, but do not let cattle use if over-saturated to point of dripping.

CONTROL OF HOUSE FLIES, FACE FLIES AND STABLE FLIES IN AND AROUND LIVESTOCK BUILDINGS:

Mix 1 pint CIODRIN E.C. in 3 gallons of water. Spray premises such as inside and outside walls (including dairy barns) caves, fences, and other resting or breeding places at least twice monthly with 1 gallon of spray per 1,000 square feet. DO NOT spray in poultry houses.

WARNING—HAZARDOUS IF SWALLOWED, INHALED, OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating and smoking. Wear clean clothing.
