Directions for Application Lactating Dairy and Beef Animals

Spraying:

For control of horn flies, stable flies, face flies, and house flies, apply a light application of Agri-Stock Spray Oil daily as a fine mist to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including legs and under side. Apply with a hand mist sprayer or automatic equipment to moisten the hair only and not in excess of 2 fluid ounces, (four tablespoons), daily per animal. For lice control make 1 to 2 applications of 3-3½ ounces of Agri-Stock Spray Oil at 14 day intervals as a fine mist spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal. Do not wet the skin due to possible skin irritation. Do not apply regularly to calves under 6 months of age. Brahman cattle should not be treated as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

Backrubbers:

For control of horn flies, face flies, and lice use Agri-Stock Spray Oil in backrubbers and face rubbers. Use 1 gallon for each 20 linear feet of burlap backrubber. Recharge every two weeks or as necessary for control. For automatic backrubbers recharge the reservoir as needed. Wrap and charge brace wires and support poles to allow animals to rub their faces and heads. Animals must rub face on rubbers for good face fly control. DO NOT let cattle use a backrubber that is over-saturated, to point of run-off, with insecticide.

General Directions

M.F.A. Agri-Stock Spray Oil is a specially prepared ready-to-use insecticide suitable for use in hand, or automatic spray equipment and in all types of Backrubbers. Agri-Stock Spray Oil is approved for lactating dairy animals. No feed-off period is necessary when used on beef cattle.

Caution: AVOID INHALATION of mist and contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water, for eyes get medical attention. Harmful if swallowed. Keep away from open flame. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate feed, water, or food stuffs. If swallowed induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Destroy Used Containers: Do not re-use for any purpose. Destroy containers by burying in an isolated area. Do Not Contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.
