CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish and birds. Do not contaminate by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. This pesticide is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting the crop, cover crop, or weeds blooming in the treatment area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container, in a cool, dry, secure area, away from fertilizer, food or feed. Keep container closed.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

NOTE: Type size same as "Keep Out of Reach of Children" front panel.

Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process; long-sleeved shirt, long pants, dust mask.

Rose and Floral Insects Controlled: Aphids, Spider Mites, Rose Slugs, Thrips, Rose Midge, Rose Chafer, Rose Leafhopper, Flea Beetles, Asiatic, Tarnished Plant Bugs, Rose Leaf Beetles, White Flies, Diabrotica Beetles.

Rose and Floral Diseases Controlled: Powdery Mildew and Black Spot on roses, Botrytis Blight on gladioli, and Leaf Spot on chrysanthemums, hollyhocks and snapdragons.

NOTE: Twice weekly applications may be necessary to prevent disease build up during rainy or high humidity periods and during periods of rapid growth, to provide coverage of new foliage and flowers.

Make uniform application to foliage and flowers so that dust is deposited on both upper and lower surfaces of plant. Best results will be obtained when application is made in early morning while dew is on or late afternoon when air is still and plants are not exposed to hot sun. For best results application should begin early in spring as growth starts and be repeated at least once weekly for balance of season.
