Your letter of February 20, 1998

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, FIFRA, is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you ship product with revised labeling:

1. Place the CAS Registry Number (CAS No. 106-46-7) directly under "Paradichlorobenzene" in the ingredient statement.
2. On the Front Panel, list your FIFRA uses as "Domestic, Indoors (Air-Tight Containers and Storage Closets) for Control of Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles". This comment also applies to your use directions.
3. Under "WARNING", delete "at high concentrations". The last sentence should read:

NOTICE: California has determined that a chemical contained in this product causes cancer based on tests performed on laboratory animals.

4. Under "FIRST AID", change the 2nd sentence as follows:

Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

This registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e) if you do not comply with these conditions. Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

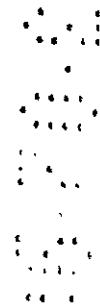

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage - Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area between 32°F and 80°F. Storage below 80°F will cause crystals to turn white; storage above 80°F will cause crystals to fuse and cake. Short-term exposure to extremely high temperatures, above 80°F, can rapidly cause caking. Inspection of containers should be made within ten days of receipt to determine whether fusing or caking has occurred in transit. Store only in closed, properly labeled containers.

Pesticide Disposal - Waste resulting from the use of this product must be disposed of at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal - Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
