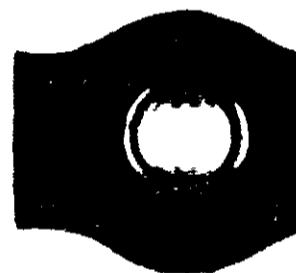


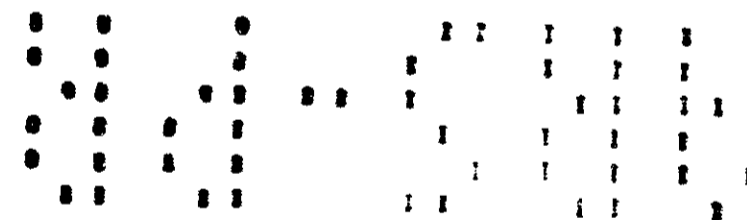
DO NOT SKID OR DROP

IMPORTANT STORAGE AND HANDLING INFORMATION - READ BEFORE USING

- Store calcium hypochlorite in a cool, dry place.
- Keep container closed when not in use.
- Keep away from heat sources, sparks, open flames and lighted tobacco products.
- Fire may result if contaminated by small amounts of foreign material such as tobacco, beverages, paint products, soaps, cleaners, oil, kerosene, rags, paper, vinegar and many other acids, organic or combustible materials.
- In case of fire, drench with water. This chemical supplies oxygen; therefore, smothering fire with a wet blanket, carbon dioxide or a dry chemical extinguisher is ineffective.
- Wash hands after handling.
- Do not re-use empty container. Destroy when empty.

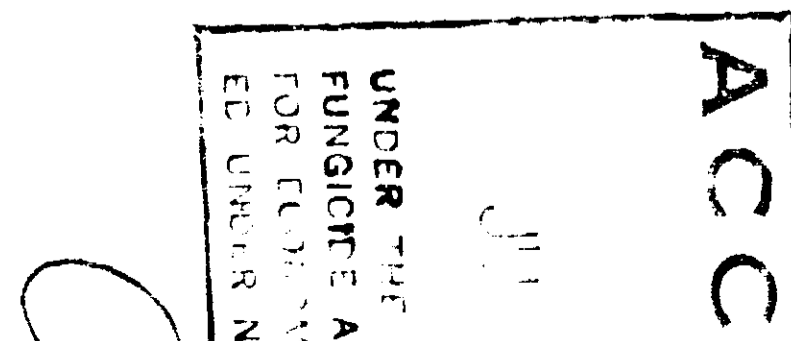

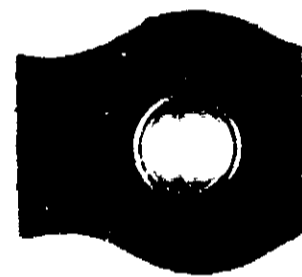
