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**USE ENTIRE BAG IN ONE APPLICATION**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Swimming pool water is subject to a build-up of a wide variety of organic contaminants including swimmer wastes, such as perspiration, ammonia compounds and natural and synthetic oils and lotions. If left untreated, the build-up of these contaminants could lead to the development of noxious odors, irritating wastes, and unsightly water clarity problems. These organic wastes which build up in swimming pools, algae, and other organisms should be removed from the pool on a regular basis to prevent their health up. This product will effectively reduce organic contamination in swimming pool water resulting in increased water clarity. Always adjust pH between 7.2 and 7.4 prior to using this product. To oxidize the organic contamination that builds up in pool water, add 1 pound of this product for every 10,000 to 15,000 gallons of water. Use the total contents of the one pound pack age at one time. **NOTE:** Add product to water; do not add water to product. Add the product to the pool by broadcasting the dry granules over the pool water surface in the deepest end of the pool. Do this while the pump is running to allow for the best product dispersion. Or, add this product directly into the skimmer while the pump is running. Make sure that all other chemicals or dials have been removed from the skimmer before adding product. Or, add the product to a large quantity of water in a clean plastic container; then sprinkle the solution into the pool.

Add this product at night or when the pool is not in use. Do not use the pool until the free chlorine residual has dropped below 4.0 ppm as determined by using a test kit. This product should be used weekly during periods of heavy use or when water temperatures are above 80°F, and once every two weeks in residential pools receiving treated sewage. Maximum treatments
