DIRECTIONS FOR USE: W53468R PILT "68" WOOD PRESERVATIVE - It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For industrial use only. Must be applied to unpainted clean, dry wood. Immerse the wooden parts by either flowcoating or dipping. Allow the wooden parts to dwell in the flowcoater or dip tank in contact with the Pilt solution a minimum of 15 seconds. Remove from solution and allow the wood to dry at 65-75°F in an area with engineered ventilation for 90 seconds prior to painting. Use aliphatic hydrocarbon solvent for clean-up.

NOTE TO USER: This product is designed to be used to treat wood millwork, plywood, outdoor furniture, and siding for above ground applications. Do not use for below or ground contact applications requiring preservative qualities. Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling freshly treated wooden parts or structures. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

WOOD PRESERVATIVE DISPOSAL: Pilt "68" Wood Preservative flowcoat or dipping material or clean-up solvent that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state, or local procedures.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.
