TO APPLY AS READY TO USE, IMMERSER THE WOODEN PARTS BY EITHER FLOODCOATING OR DIPPING. ALLOW THE WOODEN PARTS TO DWELL IN THE FLOWCOATER OR DIP TANK IN CONTACT WITH THE PILT "70" NON-CONDUCTIVE A MINIMUM OF 15 SECONDS. REMOVE FROM SOLUTION AND ALLOW THE WOOD TO DRY AT 65-75 °F IN AN AREA WITH ENGINEERED VENTILATION FOR 90 SECONDS PRIOR TO PAINTING. DO NOT USE FOR BELOW OR GROUND CONTACT APPLICATIONS REQUIRING PRESERVATIVE QUALITIES. THIS PRODUCT IS SPECIFIC TO CONVENTIONAL, NON-ELECTROSTATIC APPLICATIONS, DOES NOT PROVIDE CONDUCTIVITY TO NON-CONDUCTIVE SUBSTRATES. USE ALIPHATIC HYDROCARBON SOLVENT FOR CLEAN UP SOLVENT.
