- d. Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:
 - i. Delete "DANGER: Corrosive, causes skin damage" and "May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled".
 - ii. Add "CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin" and "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling".
- e. Under Environmental Hazards, change "Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters".
