This is in response to your amendment to reflect basic product name change from "Sustain Algae Destroyer" to "PPG Algae Destroyer."

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable subject to the following comments:

1. Place the Statement of Practical Treatment on the front panel.
2. Revise the first sentence in the ingestion statement to read:

"If Swallowed drink large amounts of water.

3. Revise the Environmental Hazards in accordance with PR Notice 93-10.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

The proposed product name change has been made a part of our records for this file.

ALGAE DESTROYER

- A powerful, fast-acting algicide • Dissolves quickly • Kills green and black algae
- Decolorizes dead algae • Breaks down and removes unfilterable dead algae.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Apply **ALGAE DESTROYER** by broadcasting the dry granules over the pool water surface. To prevent any possible bleaching effect on vinyl-lined pools, use a pool brush to disperse and dissolve any undissolved granules setting on the bottom of the pool.

To Kill Green and Black Algae:

1. Scrub sides and bottom of pool loosening attached algae.
2. Adjust pH of water between 7.2 and 7.4.
3. Add 20 oz. of **ALGAE DESTROYER** for every 10,000 gallons of water. (8 oz. is approximately 1 cup.)
4. Run circulation system overnight and vacuum settled algae from pool the next day.
5. Algae can be persistent. If algae is still present, repeat steps 3-4.
6. Do not enter pool until the free chlorine residual is below 3 ppm.
7. Resume regular pool sanitization and maintenance practice.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep product in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well ventilated area. Keep away from heat sources, sparks, open flames, lighted tobacco products, and other chemicals. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. **CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. After use, rinse empty container thoroughly with water then place in trash collection. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

IN CASE OF FIRE: Drench with water. **ALGAE DESTROYER** supplies oxygen; therefore, attempts to smother fire with a wet blanket, carbon dioxide, or a dry chemical extinguisher are ineffective. **IN CASE OF SPILL OR LEAK:** Use extreme caution. Contamination may cause fire or violent reaction. Sweep up spilled material and dissolve in water. Then immediately use solution as directed.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID) EYE OR SKIN CONTACT: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing. For eye contact, get immediate medical attention. **INHALATION:** Remove to fresh air. If signs of irritation or discomfort occur, take immediately to a hospital or physician. **SWALLOWING:** If conscious, drink large quantities of water followed by any common cooking (vegetable) oil, if available. Do not induce vomiting. Take immediately to a hospital or physician. If vomiting occurs, administer additional water. If unconscious, or in convulsions, take immediately to a hospital. Do not attempt to induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

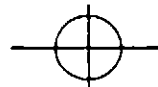
