DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label directions. PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 is used

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs that do not contain fish. For maximum effectiveness, use PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 in decorative fountains, and ponds containing heavy growth of algae. Use PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 to using PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 2 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. To remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of algae growth in decorative fountains, add initially 13 to 24 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made 4 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, and hot tubs that do not contain fish require an initial dose of 2 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. For hot tubs, whirlpools, hot tubs, decorative fountains, or hot tubs that do not contain fish, add 2 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 should be made every 4 days for maintenance.

PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 will prevent algae growth during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use.

For pools treated during the swimming season and are free of algae, add 21 fluid ounces of algicide per 10,000 gallons of water. For season pools have some visible algae growth, add 25 fluid ounces of PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. Repeat the treatment one or more times during the season if necessary.

PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 is compatible with other chlorine products used to treat pools and spas and is effective against algae. PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 can be used in conjunction with other chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of chlorine required. However, do not mix PITTCLOR ALGICIDE 30 with other chlorine products.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Keep container closed when not in use. Leaking container should be placed in a plastic bag and discarded in trash. All pesticides should be kept out of reach of children. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in plastic.
