For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial fluid ounces of PITTLOR ALGICIDE 60. Remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of PITTLOR ALGICIDE 60 per 10,000 gallons of water.
