PILT-NF4 CONCENTRATE MUST BE REDUCED WITH 4 PARTS WATER TO MAKE THE PILT NF READY TO USE. DO NOT APPLY AS IS.

For industrial use only. Must be applied to unpainted, clean, dry wood.

PILT-NF4 CONCENTRATE protects against decay producing fungi, staining fungi and surface mold.

PRODUCT USES: This product is recommended for millwork, shingles [not asbestos], shakes, clapboards, smooth and rough-cut siding, plywood, decks, porches, railings, structural support timbers, flatbeds, coldframes and greenhouses. Do not use for below or ground contact applications requiring preservative qualities. Do not use on wood that will be used in contact with food, feed or potable water or where prolonged skin contact will occur. Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use on lumber that can be used where dairy cattle or livestock can come in contact with the treated wood.

PILT-NF4 CONCENTRATE MUST BE REDUCED TO USE. Immerse individual wooden parts by either flowcoating or dipping. Allow the parts to dwell in the flowcoater or dip tank in contact with PILT-NF4 a minimum of 30 seconds. Bundle of parts should be immersed for three minutes. Remove from solution and, prior to painting, allow to dry at 65-75°F in an area with engineered ventilation. Use water for clean-up solvent.

Cut and machine wood prior to treatment if possible. If not, liberally apply two coatings of preservative to all joints, cracks, cut-ends, holes or other openings.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store near heat sources. Do not use the product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste dispos. ¹ facility.
