DIRECTIONS:

For Disinfecting Bathroom, Toilet, Bathtub, Lavatory: Use 1/2 cup (= 4 fl. ozs.) of Delta Pine Oil in 1 gallon of water and let mixture remain on surface for 10 minutes.

For Cleaning and Scrubbing: Pour 1/4 cup (= 2 fl. ozs.) of Delta Pine Oil into 1 gallon of tap water. Use the resulting milky liquid. Do not use on asphalt tiles.

For Deodorizing Toilet Bowls, Garbage Pails, Etc.: Pour 1/4 cup (= 2 fl. ozs.) into water and let it stay for a while.

For Washing White or Color-Fast Clothes: Use 4 tablespoons Delta Pine Oil for a Washtub or Washing Machine (about 8 gals. contents), filled with warm water and soap. Rinse well.

For Diapers, Soiled Baby Clothes, Etc.: Soak diapers in a bucket of water with 1/4 cup (= 2 fl. ozs.) Delta Pine Oil, discard water, wash diapers with soap and water and 2 tablespoons of Delta Pine Oil. Rinse thoroughly.

For Baby Playpens, Toys, Etc.: Pour 1/4 cup of Delta Pine Oil into pail of water for cleaning.

For Bathing Dogs: Use 2 fl. ozs. of Delta Pine Oil to pail (= 3 gal.) of water. This will help to remove fleas and odors. Do not let bath water contact pet's eyes and ears.

For the Sick Room: A small amount of Delta Pine Oil in a pail of water in the sick room will remove disagreeable odors and help in maintaining sanitary conditions.

For Cleaning Combs and Hairbrushes: Soak in a mixture of 4 to 5 caps full of Delta Pine Oil in a basin of water.

For Removing Paint and Cleaning Paint Brushes: Use Delta Pine Oil in full strength, then add small amount of water for soaking. Let stand for a while and then rinse thoroughly with water.

For Washing Hands Dirty from Grease, Paint, Oil and Grime: Pour small quantity of Delta Pine Oil into palm of hand. Rub into soiled hands then rinse with water.

If splashed into eyes, flush well with tap water.

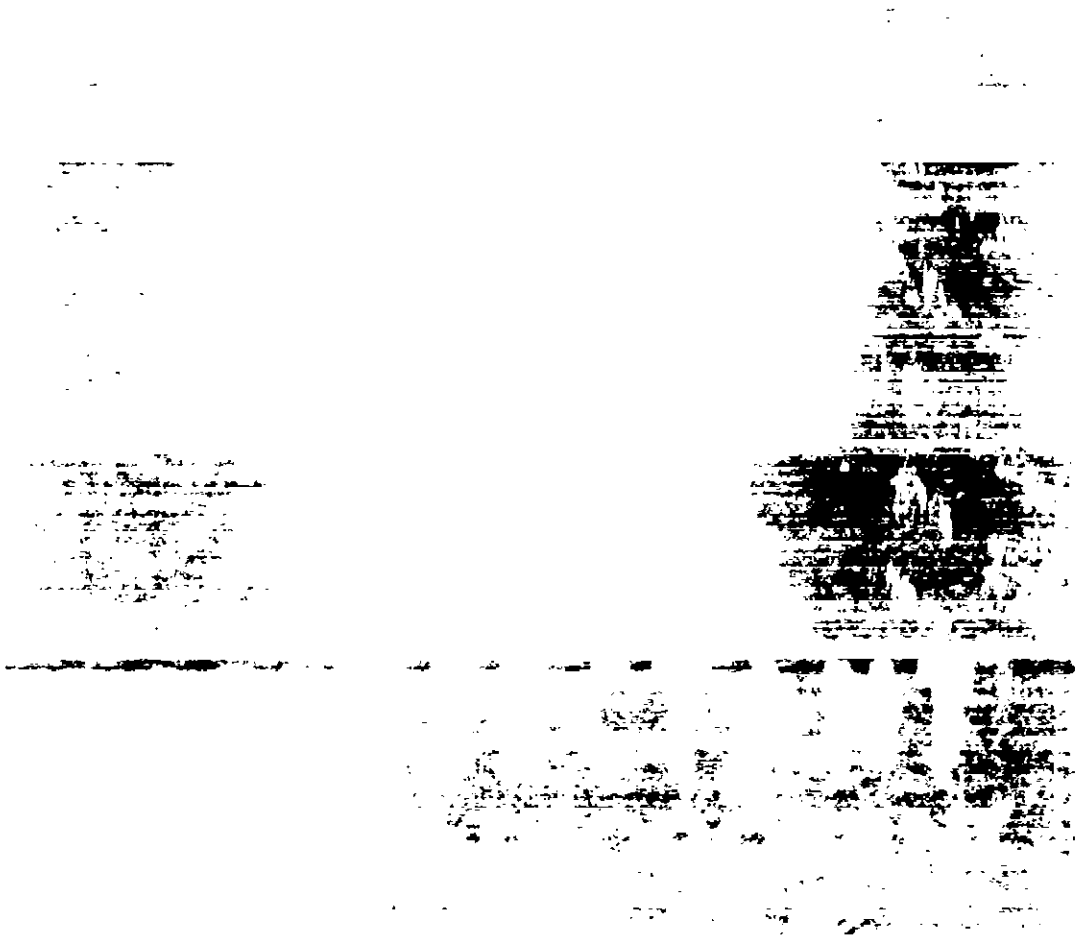
