PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing dust. May cause irritation of nose, throat or skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. Do not use for medical purposes or as a feed supplement.

FIRST AID: IF IN EYES, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician if irritation persists. **FOR SKIN CONTACT,** wash with soap and water. **IF INHALED** and overcome by vapor or dust, remove immediately from exposure and call a physician. Administer artificial respiration if breathing is irregular or has stopped **IF SWALLOWED,** drink 1 to 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by sticking finger in back of throat. Call a physician.

REENTRY INTERVAL: Do not reenter treated areas within 24 hours

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE PRECAUTIONS: Some fruits and other plants are susceptible to injury from sulphur under certain climatic conditions. The user is

advised not to use sulphur on any crop unless local use has proven that sulphur is safe in that locality. Do not allow dust to reach cucumbers, squash or melons. During periods of high temperatures, sulphur may burn foliage and fruit. Do not make sulphur applications at excessively high temperatures. Do not use sulphur within 4 weeks of an oil application. If the crop to be treated will be used for commercial canning or freezing purposes, consult food processor before applying sulphur.

PEANUTS: To control leaf spot, use 15 to 20 pounds per acre. On Spanish peanuts, make the first application when spots appear on basal leaves, usually 60-65 days after planting. Repeat applications at two week intervals until at least 3 applications have been made. On runner peanuts, apply the first dust about one week later than for Spanish peanuts; then apply 3 additional applications at two week intervals. If rain occurs within 24 hours of an application, repeat the application as soon as practicable.

PEACHES: To control brown rot, apply at the rate of 25 to 30 pounds per acre. Follow locally issued schedule for time of applications. Avoid application during periods of high humidity and high temperatures above 90°F.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal. Pesticide that cannot be used according to label directions must be disposed of according to federal, state or local procedures. Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residues into application equipment. Dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.
