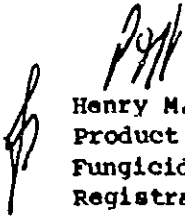

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTE TO USER: Do not use this product as a feed supplement. Do not apply this material to Cucumbers, Melons or Squash. Avoid applying this material during very hot periods of the day. When this product is used with Lead Arsenate, 8 pounds of Hydrated Lime or Basic Zinc Sulphate should be added for each 10 gallons of spray.

PEACHES AND PLUMS: To control Brown Rot and Scab use 1 ounce (3 level tablespoons) per gallon of water (6 lbs. per 100 gal.). Follow locally issued spray schedule for number and frequency of applications. Usually 6 applications are made. No. 1 - when 1/4 petals have fallen. No. 2 - when 1/4 shucks have shed. No. 3 - two weeks later. No. 4 - two weeks after No. 3. No. 5 - four weeks before harvest. No. 6 - two weeks before harvest.

FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS: To control spider mites and the diseases listed below use Nutonex as a dust or spray using 1 ounce (3 level tablespoons) per gallon of water (6 lbs. per 100 gal.). Applications should be made at 5 to 7 day intervals beginning when the disease first appears and continuing until all danger from the disease has passed. During periods of humid or rainy weather it may be necessary to make applications as often as every 2 to 3 days.

POWDERY MILDEW: Aster, Chrysanthemum, Cosmos, Dahlia, Daisy, Delphinium, Dogwood, Evonymus, Golden Fleece, Hibiscus, Honeysuckle, Hydrangea, Lady's Mantle, Ligustrum, Lilac, Myrtle, Phlox, Poplar, Silver Vine, Rose, Spiraea, Sunflower, Verbena, Willow and Zinnia.

LEAF SPOTS: Calendula, Cherry Laurel, Clematis, Columbine, English Ivy, Foxgloves, Hydrangea, Petunia, Phlox, Sage, Smilac and Snapdragon.

BLACK SPOT: Rose.

ROSE POWDERY MILDEW: Rose.

BOTRYTIS BLIGHT: Hydrangea.

RED SPIDERS: Arborvitae, Carnation, Cedars, Chrysanthemum, Clematis, Hydrangea, Rose, Snapdragon and Sweetpeas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store pesticide in original container and place in a locked storage area. Do not reuse container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspapers and discard in trash.
