DIRECTIONS

AGITATE BEFORE USING

CAUTION: Make no application of oil if freezing temperatures are expected within 4 hours. Do not follow a winter spray with oil under two weeks or no injury may result. Do not use oil within two weeks of an application of sulfur or lime sulfur.

DECIDUOUS FRUIT TREES, ORNAMENTAL SHRUBBERY and BERRIES:

To control scale insects dilute with water at the rate of 20 parts water to 1 part oil. Emulsion is sprayed onto the plant surface. Do not spray in windy conditions. Do not spray with oil until 2 weeks after the last application of sulfur or lime sulfur.

HARDY EVERGREEN SHRUBBERY:

To control scale insects dilute with water at the rate of 20 parts water to 1 part oil. Emulsion is sprayed onto the plant surface. Do not spray in windy conditions.
