APHIDS, THRIPS, LEAFMINERS, CUCUMBER BEETLES: On Boxwood Azalea Ruse Chrysanthemum, Larkspur, and other itowers, shrubs, and trees, use the pint per 100 gattons of water or I teaspooliful to I galton ut water.

LACEBUG: In Azalea Evracantha and Rhododenorum, use 1; pints per loc gallons of water or 1; teaspoons to 1 gallon. Apply in spring when immature insects first appear and repeat as necessary.
