HOW TO USE

PECAN PHYLLOXERA and SHOOT CURCULIO on PECANS: Apply a spray concentration of 1 quart 20% Lindane per 100 gallons of water, thoroughly wetting the foliage at approximately 30 gallons of spray per tree. Do not apply more than 450 gallons per acre. Apply by air blast sprayer when the pecan buds are beginning to burst. This is early to mid-April. Make only one application. Do not graze treated areas.
