The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you:

Submit one copy of your final printed label incorporating the following corrections before you release the product for shipment.

1. Add the following ventilation statement as required in the 1988 Malathion Reregistration Standard for all malathion products allowing for indoor use.

"Use only with adequate ventilation. After using this product indoors, ventilate thoroughly before occupying enclosed spaces."

2. Since your submitted label does not bear any outdoor uses, revise the "Environmental Hazards" statements to read as follows.

"This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes."

If this condition is not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the



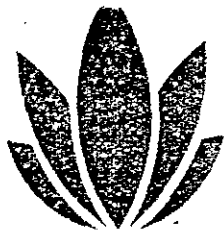

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Seek medical attention. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash contaminated area with soap and water. **IF IN EYES:** Flush eyes with copious amounts of water and seek medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Malathion is a moderate cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal.

Store pesticide in original container in a cool, dry storage area. Open pesticide container and reseal prior to storage. Protect from moisture, excessive heat or cold. Do not mix with other pesticides or fertilizers. Do not store pesticides in stacks. **PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Contaminate water, food or feed. Do not reuse material resulting from the use of this pesticide. **DISPOSAL:** Completely empty container. Then dispose of empty container by incineration, or if allowed, by burning. If burned, stay
