The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, As Amended (FIFRA), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit two copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment.
2. Submit your updated Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) reflecting your new supplier product.

The most recent CSF in our files for the product was submitted in 1984 and cites a supplier product registration which has since been transferred to another company. You are reminded that your supplier product label must allow for the formulation of the product for the uses appearing on your product label.


3. Verify that the product name, ALLPRO Grain Protectant Dust represents a change in the primary or basic name of the product. This name is not in our registration records system as a

product name for the subject registration. Please be aware that all label amendments must be submitted for the primary or basic product name labeling.

FIRST AID

IF Swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Seek medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

TO CONTROL: Confused flour beetle, rice weevil, granary weevil, sawtoothed grain beetle, flat grain beetle, red flour beetle, rusty grain beetle, lesser grain borer and Indian meal moth.

APPLICATION: Apply dust at the rate of 6 pounds per 100 bushels as the grain or seed is being loaded or turned into final storage. To protect uninfested grain in storage from Indian meal moth, apply dust to the surface of the grain at the rate of 3 pounds per 100 square feet of surface area. Apply the dust evenly over the surface immediately after grain is loaded into storage. Repeat application if necessary.

- If swallowed:**
- Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
