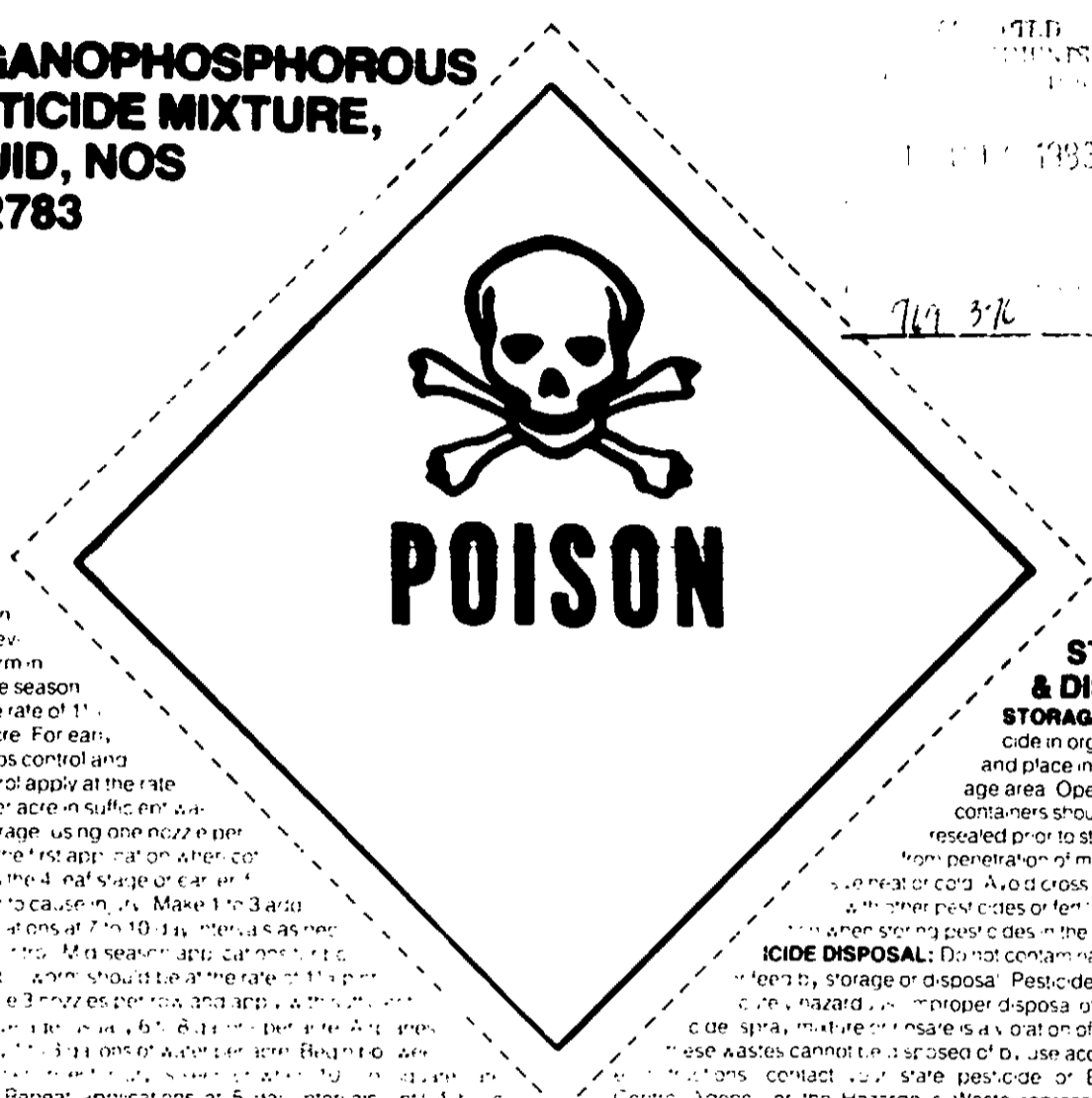

trol boll weev-  
and bollworm in  
mid and late season  
apply at the rate of 1 1/2  
pints per acre. For ear-  
ly season thrips control and  
weevil control apply at the rate  
of 2 1/2 pints per acre in sufficient wa-  
ter for coverage, using one nozzle per  
row. Make the first application when cot-  
ton reaches the 4 leaf stage or earlier if  
thrips need to cause injury. Make 1 to 3 addi-  
tional applications at 7 to 10 day intervals as nec-  
essary for control. Mid season applications for boll  
weevil control should be at the rate of 1 1/2 pints  
per acre. Use 3 nozzles per row and apply with sufficient  
water to make a spray 6 to 8 inches per acre. Apply  
spray at 1 1/2 to 3 gallons of water per acre. Begin to weevil  
control with mid season spray at water 10 to 12 square in-  
ch diameter. Repeat applications at 5 day intervals until 4 to 5  
leaves are present. Repeat a series of 4 applications of mixture at  
5 to 10 day intervals. Anytime bollworm eggs and 4 to 5 small  
worms are found per 100 terminals examined, apply the material  
at a 5 to 10 day interval until control is obtained. For late season pro-  
tection apply 1 1/2 pints per acre at 4 to 5 day intervals  
as necessary.

**SOYBEANS** Control the worm on soybean and alfalfa in  
cotton producing states or use 1 1/2 pints per acre in sufficient  
water. Airplanes should apply 1 1/2 to 2 pints per acre  
and ground equipment 6 to 8 gallons. Begin  
application when you find one worm per 3 feet of row.  
Repeat applications at 4 to 5 day intervals as necessary.

**STORAGE:** Store pesti-  
cide in original container  
and place in a locked stor-  
age area. Opened pesticide  
containers should be securely  
resealed prior to storage. Protect  
from penetration of moisture, exces-  
sive heat or cold. Avoid cross contamination  
with other pesticides or fertilizers. Use cau-  
tion when storing pesticides in the stacks. **PESTI-  
CIDE DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food
