ANTIDOTE: IF SWALLOWED and victim is conscious, give 1 pint of water and 1/2 tsp of salt in a glass of water. If unconscious, give 1 pint of water and 1/2 tsp of salt in a glass of water and repeat every 15 minutes.

Atropine is antidotal. **NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Administer atropine sulfate in large doses, TWO to FOUR mg. intravenously or intramuscularly as soon as cyanosis is overcome. Repeat at 5 to 10 minute intervals until signs of atropinization appear. 2-PAM Chloride is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. **DO NOT GIVE MORPHINE OR TRANQUILIZERS.** **IF ON SKIN:** In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

DIRECTIONS

TOBACCO PLANT BED: To control Blue Mold, Aphids, Midge and Green June Beetle larvae, dust small plants for the first through the fourth dusting at the rate of 1 1/2 pounds per 100 square yards of plant bed. Increase the rate to 2 1/2 pounds for the fifth and sixth applications, and subsequent applications at 3 1/2 pounds. Begin dusting at first sign of insect damage. Repeat as necessary. At first signs of blue mold, dust at maximum recommended rate.

Begin dusting as soon as blue mold appears in your tobacco section and continue twice each week until all danger of blue mold has passed or until all plants are affected and recovery is evident. Dust after every rain even if 3 or 4 dustings are required each week. Plants may be dusted when either wet or dry if the wind is not blowing. Beds less than 4 feet wide can best be dusted through the cover if it is at least 6 inches above the ground. For wider beds, it will be necessary to remove the cover and walk along lanes every 5 to 6 feet.

A good hand crank duster with a delivery tube several feet long and at least 1 1/2 inches in diameter is most satisfactory for applying dust. Sacks or the small plunger-type dusters are unsatisfactory.
