NURSERY STOCK. To control Imported Fire Ants and Japanese Beetle Larvae. Apply only on land with nursery stock grown for balled and burlapped, bareroot or container stock. Apply at the rate of 5 pints per acre (1/4 cup in 5 gallons of water applied to 1000 sq. ft.) in sufficient water for coverage. Disc into soil before planting. On existing plantings, water thoroughly after application.
