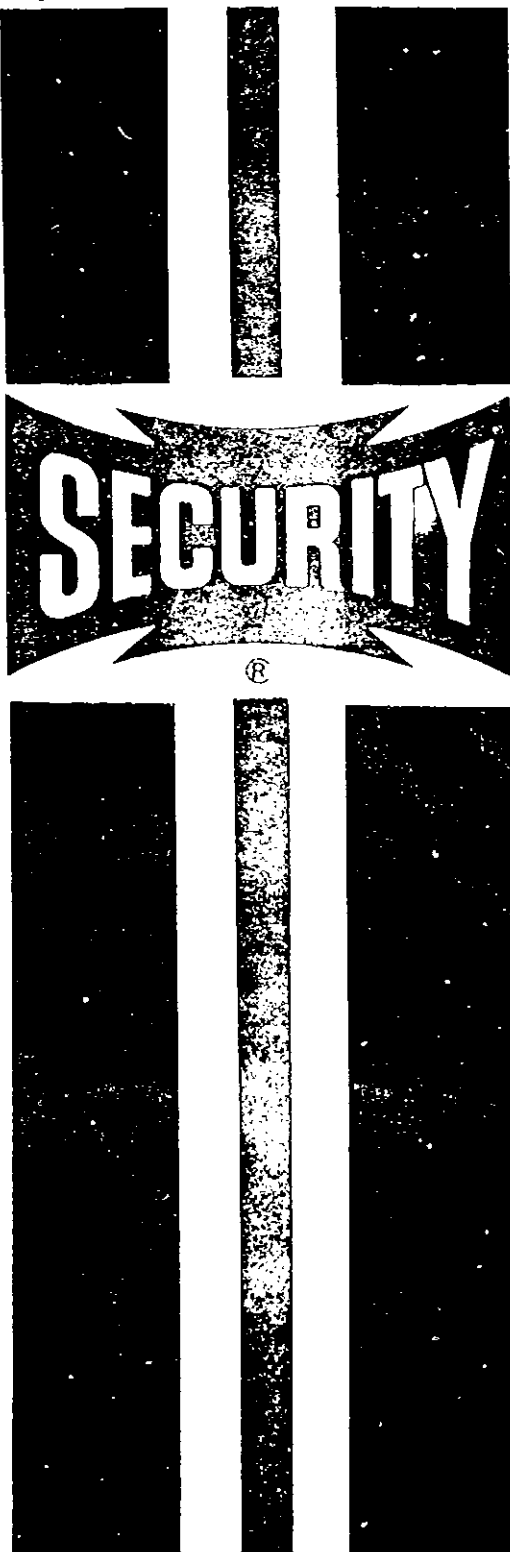

REENTRY INTERVAL: Do not reenter treated areas within 24 hours.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

USE PRECAUTIONS: Some fruits and other plants are susceptible to injury from sulphur under certain climatic conditions. The user is advised not to use sulphur on any crop unless local use has proven that sulphur is safe in that locality. Do not allow dust to reach cucumbers, squash or melons. During periods of high temperatures, sulphur may burn foliage and fruit. Do not make sulphur applications at excessively high temperatures. Do not use sulphur within 4 weeks of an oil application. If the crop to be treated will be used for commercial canning or freezing purposes, consult food processor before applying sulphur.

CITRUS: To control rust mite, use 1/2 to 1 1/2 pounds per tree, depending on tree size. Apply dust when air is calm and leaves are covered with dew, preferably at night. Do not apply during periods of high temperatures.

PEACHES, PLUMS: To control rust mite, apply 25 to 45 pounds per acre for number and frequency of applications made. No. 1 - when 2/5 petals have shed, No. 3 - two weeks later; No. 6 - two weeks before harvest, and No. 6. **APPLES:** To control apple scab, apply 25 to 45 pounds per acre. Dust thoroughly as necessary to cover new foliage during cover spray period. Macintosh and certain other varieties may be susceptible under certain conditions.

OUTDOOR FLOWERS, ORNAMENTALS: To control mite, leaf spot and black spot and red spiders, dust thoroughly.

BEANS: To control rust and red spider, apply 25 to 30 pounds per acre. Beans are susceptible to sulphur injury. Do not apply within 3 days after application.

PEANUTS: To control leaf spot and rust, apply 25 to 30 pounds per acre at 10 day intervals or as necessary when rust appears and continue to within 4 weeks of harvest.

POULTRY (chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, pigeons): To control deplumage, apply 25 to 30 pounds per acre into leathers. Apply dust thoroughly into cracks and crevices of houses. Force dust into cracks and crevices. Need 24 hours.

STORAGE

Do not contaminate water, food or feed. Pesticide that cannot be used should be disposed of according to federal regulations. Empty bag by shaking and tapping. Empty residues into a sanitary landfill or by other means approved by local authorities.
