PRECAUTIONS: Apply SECURITY Crabgrass Preventer to the turf prior to weed seed germination. It will not control established grass weeds. Do not use on bentgrass or dichondra turfs. It should not be applied in the spring to bluegrass planted the previous fall, nor to newly sprigged areas of Bermudagrass, St. Augustine or Centipede until these turfs are well established since root inhibition may result. Do not reseed within 42 days after application. Rates over 9 pounds to 2500 square feet may thin fine leaved fescues.

GRASS WEEDS CONTROLLED: Smooth crabgrass, hairy crabgrass, watergrass, barnyard grass, goosegrass, yellow and green foxtail.

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply SECURITY Crabgrass Preventer to the turf in early spring before germination of annual grass weeds. This varies by region and climatic zone. Consult agricultural experiment station or extension service weed specialist for accurate germination dates in your area. Application should be made approximately March 1 in the latitude of north Florida and the Gulf Coast area to Texas, March 15 from the coastal area of North Carolina through central South Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, Mississippi and northern Louisiana, April 1 in central and western North Carolina, except the mountain area, central and eastern Tennessee, except the mountain area, and southern Missouri and northern Arkansas, April 15 in Kentucky, southern Indiana and southern Illinois and northern Missouri. In southern areas where crabgrass and other annual weed grasses germinate into late summer or early fall, a second application of SECURITY Crabgrass Preventer at the recommended rate may be made 4 to 6 months after the spring application for continued weed control.

RATE OF APPLICATION: On all turf grasses listed except fine-leaved fescue, apply at the rate of 12 pounds to 2500 square feet. On fine-leaved fescue, apply at the rate of 9 pounds to 2500 square feet. Water thoroughly after application.

HOW TO APPLY: For best results, apply with a fertilizer spreader evenly over the turf area. A more uniform application can be made by spreading half the required amount over the area to be treated, and then applying the other half at right angles or crosswise.
