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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use on all woody plants. This product is a hormone which stimulates the growth of roots. It is a highly effective rooting compound for all woody plants. It is a natural plant hormone which stimulates the growth of roots.

CARE AND SELECTION OF CUTTINGS - Select sturdy 4 to 6 inch cuttings of the current season's growth. The basal end may be cut at an angle or straight. Remove any lower buds or leaves from cuttings. Cuttings should be kept in water or by wrapping in damp paper until ready to plant. Do not allow cuttings to become dry or wilted from the time they are cut until they are rooted. This may be 3 to 5 weeks or longer, depending on plant species. Cuttings should be shaded while roots are developing. The best temperature for cuttings is between 70° to 75° F.

HOW TO USE - First, if already moist, the basal ends of the cuttings should be slightly moistened before treatment. (except geraniums). Dip the basal end of the cutting into the rooting powder about 1/2 inch deeper than it will be set in the rooting medium. Remove excessive powder by tapping the stem on the side on the container. Plant treated cuttings in the rooting medium at a slight angle. Firm medium around cutting to avoid air pockets and water thoroughly. The rooting medium below the surface must not be allowed to become dry.

ROOTING MEDIUM - Plant cuttings in a pre-mixed rooting medium or prepare your own by mixing 1 part moss with 1 part sand by volume or use sand only until cuttings are rooted.
